Spirit of Nicholas Sailing Fund Recently Established at the Community Foundation of Anne Arundel County Announces First Grant to Key School

ANNAPOLIS, MD—On Monday, October 7, the Spirit of Nicholas Sailing Fund Advisors announced the first grant award of \$5,000 to Key School's Varsity and JV Sailing Teams. The grant funding will provide financial assistance to the Key School Sailing Teams for equipment, supplies, travel and STEM sailing education for the Fall 2024 and Spring 2025 athletic seasons. The Donor Advised Fund is administered by the CFAAC and together with the Spirit of Nicholas Sailing Fund Advisors determine where the grants are rewarded annually. "I am pleased to award Key School's Sailing Team with the first grant award. Nicholas sailed competitively at the Key School for four years and was team Captain his senior year. Sailing at Key made a positive impact on Nicholas," said Founder Heather East.

The charitable purpose of the Spirit of Nicholas Sailing Fund is to support organizations who encourage young sailors to actively participate in junior training programs, scholastic teams, competitive racing and related maritime and STEM educational activities in Annapolis and on the Chesapeake Bay.
